## PRIVACY POLICY (GDPR)

Conformed to the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), protecting your privacy on the internet is a priority. On our web page we might collect certain information about users. See below which information could be collect and the purposes of their use.

#### INFORMATION COLLECTED

Information about users are of two types: personal data (such as names, address, telephone numbers, e-mail) and aggregate data (such as site traffic, number of visitors who connect every day).

- Personal data: Personal data are collected when users provide me with their information, for example by purchasing one of our services. When you request information via our web page it is generally required to provide your name, e -mail, address and telephone number.
   Credit card and payments information are required only for purchases and via PayPal, so we don't hold or have access to any information about your credit card, bank details and passwords, which are never stored or recorded.
- If you send personal correspondence, such as e-mails or letters, it is possible that these information are collected in a specific file.

  Aggregate datas: The use of our web site might be monitored to keep track
- Aggregate datas: The use of our web site might be monitored to keep track
  automatically of certain information, such as number of visitors. These could include
  the URL of origin, time of last use and the IP address. The IP address is a number
  automatically assigned to your computer whenever you access the network. The
  Web server, or computers that host web pages, automatically identify your
  computer by the IP address that is recorded when the user requests access to the
  site. The IP address is not linked to any personally identifiable information, then,
  although the session is recorded, the user remains anonymous.

# **COOKIES POLICY**

Cookies are small files that website may place on your computer or mobile device ("Device") via your web browser. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your Device's hard drive. Some of the cookies store information required for this website to function properly. Other cookies help to improve the website use by tracking how many people visit the website, which pages they visit, and how frequently.

Some cookies are deleted at the end of each browser session. These are called "session cookies". They allow website operators to link your actions during a browser session. A browser session starts when a user opens the browser window and finishes when they close the browser window. Other cookies remain on your Device for a longer period (as specified in the cookie). These are called "persistent cookies". They are activated each time you visit the website that created that particular cookie.

Cookies used on our site are categorised as follows:

- Strictly Necessary Cookies: Cookies which let you move around the website and use essential features. Without these cookies, services you have asked for cannot be provided. Please note that these cookies do not gather any information about you that could be used for marketing or remembering where you've been on the internet. We use these strictly necessary cookies to remember selections you've made or information you've entered on forms when you navigate to different pages during a web browser session; from making sure you connect to the right service when changes are made to the way the website works.
  Route users to specific applications of a service or specific servers.
- Performance Cookies: Cookies which collect information about how you use the
  website (e.g., which pages you visit and if you experience any errors). These cookies
  do not collect any information that could identify you and are only used to help me
  to improve how the website works, understand what interests our users, and
  measure how effective our advertising is. We use Performance cookies Web
  Analytics (Google Analytics) to provide statistics on how our website is used and
  Error Management to help us improve the website by measuring any errors that
  occur.
- Functionality Cookies: Cookies which are used to provide services or to remember settings to improve your visit.
- Targeting Cookies: Cookies which are linked to services provided by third parties, such as 'Like' buttons and 'Share' buttons. Third parties provide these services in return for recognizing that you have visited our website. We use Targeting cookies to link to social networks like Facebook, who may subsequently use information about your visit to target advertising to you on other websites; provide advertising agencies with information on your visit so that they can present you with advertisements in which you may be interested. Some of the cookies used on this site are managed by third parties. You may refer to the third parties' website privacy notifications for further information. We do not control these sites or their use of cookies and we bear no responsibility or liability for them.

Most Web browsers accept cookies automatically and allow you to control most of them through the browser settings, although you are not required to accept them.

If you wish to disable cookies you can change the settings of your browser. Please note that disabling cookies you may not be able to register or to use all features of our website.
